**Re:** Religious Freedom Week 2021: Solidarity in Freedom and

Diocesan Patronal Feast Day Mass on June 22, 2021

In a communication dated April 28, 2021, His Eminence, Timothy Cardinal Dolan, Chairman of the Committee for Religious Liberty of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, reminded the Bishops of the United States that **Religious Freedom Week 2021: Solidarity in Freedom** takes place from June 22 – June 29, 2021, beginning with the Feast of Saints John Fisher and Thomas More, and concluding with the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul.
